

Clas Ohlson sales development in June 2013

Sales rose 1% in June to SEK 506 M (503). In local currencies, sales increased 3%. Compared with the same month in 2012, 16 stores have been added and the total number of stores on June 30 2013 was 178. Mail order/Internet sales during the month was SEK 8 M (7).
